An important focus of the project is developing capacities of Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) for Natural Resource Management (NRM). To develop learning material on NRM, MoPR sought feedback on:

## Payments using Biometric system under MGNREGA in West Bengal

West Bengal is introducing biometric system for payments in the 100-days job scheme under MGNREGA to do away with corruption. West Midnapore district will be the first to implement the system within two weeks and West Bengal will be the second state after undivided Andhra Pradesh to introduce it to weed out corruption in fund disbursal.

### Rajasthan to constitute 5th State Finance Commission

Government of Rajasthan has announced the formation of Fifth State Finance Commission which would be a five-member body headed by an expert on public issues as its Chairperson. Others members would include experts on financial matters. Tenure of this commission would be from April 1, 2015 to March 31, 2020 and it would give recommendations towards Panchayati Raj and Local Bodies' welfare and their financial matters.

This platform will initially operate as a call centre and later mobile application version will also be launched. This will not only entertain public grievances that require government intervention but also register complaints pertaining to corruption and irregularities.
