Scale up action on protection of the ozone layer from ozone depleting substances by phasing out the use of Hydrochlorofluorocarbons (HCFC) in the foam manufacturing sector in Jamaica and thereby contributing to Jamaica's compliance with the Montreal Protocol.

National Implementation Plan for Persistent Organic Pollutants (POP)

Enabling Actions (Kigali Amendment)

The project aims to prevent the emission of up to 105 million tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent of greenhouse gases, helping to avoid up to 0.5 degree Celsius of global temperature rise by the year 2100 while continuing to protect the ozone layer.
