### LOCAL ELECTIONS AND GOVERNANCE

The municipality of Sebha developed a Capacity Development Action Plan, coupled with the training of municipality officials and the provision of small grants to enhance service delivery and to respond to the COVID 19 pandemic.

Capacity development in Sebha on community participation, communication and outreach, Law 59 and local administration for the municipal council.



### REVIVING LOCAL ECONOMIC RECOVERY

Entrepreneurs in Sebha benefitted from small grants along with training and mentoring to start new businesses or restart businesses affected by the conflict or COVID 19 pandemic, creating 51 jobs, including for women.

Rehabilitated Women's Literacy Center allowing more than 100 women from Sebha to acquire vocational skills that increase their employability.



### IMPROVING DELIVERY OF BASIC SERVICES

Improved access to education, healthcare, culture, and power networks contributing to stability is an incentive for IDP returns.

Interventions prioritized through participatory community consultations - in close coordination with municipalities and line ministries and based on sound conflict analysis.



### RECONCILIATION AND SOCIAL COHESION

Convened and trained active mediators, legal experts, and tribal leaders who participated, led, or executed peace initiatives and traditional reconciliation efforts.

Capacity CSOs strengthened to design and implement local initiatives aimed at fostering social cohesion and peacebuilding informed by conflict sensitivity analysis, and in partnership with local actors, community leaders, activists, specially youth and women.

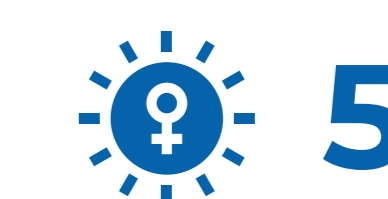

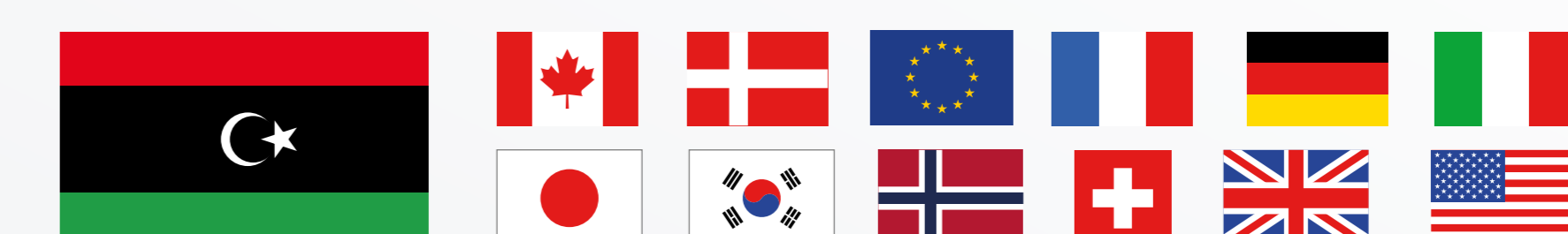
