## Demographic characteristics of women and girls with disabilities $\Downarrow_{0}$.

They represent $4.8 \%$ of the female population of the country


Out of 10 women with disabilities
$12 \% 1$ is young (aged 18-34)
$71 \% \quad 7$ are adults of able bodied (aged 35-64)
$17 \% 2$ are elderly (over 65 years old)


1 in 2 persons with disabilities is a woman


4 out of 10 children with disabilities are girls

© In villages - $\mathbf{8}$ out of 10 work on their own account in agriculture ( $82 \%$ )

© In towns - 4 out of 10 are employees (38\%)

© Almost all 10 women benefited from professional counselling or information (98\%)
