


## ->> Demographic characteristics of women from rural areas <->

- Average age is 39 years old
- Average life expectancy is 74 years old
- **2** out of **10** women are aged 60 and over



There are **70** elderly women to **100** women of working age (16-59 years old)

#### ->> Education level of women from rural areas <->

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Less than **half** of women aged 15 and over have higher, secondary specialized or secondary vocational education (46,4%)

### -> Access of women from rural areas to health services <-

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- About 1/5 of rural women assess their health condition as bad or very bad
- 19,2%
- They suffer almost 2 times more often than women in urban areas from chronic diseases, which need continuous treatment, as well as osteoarticular disorders, nervous system diseases, tumours

Over 1/3 of rural women refused visiting the family doctor




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
On average, they make **3.4** visits to the doctor on annual basis

Among the reasons for giving up doctor's consultations were

Insufficiency of financial means - for 1 in 4 women



Lack of health insurance policy - for 1 in 10 women


