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## Agenda 2030 nationalization

Sustainable Development Goals nationalized indicators were revised.

UNDP supports the Voluntary National Review process, planned in July 2020, during the High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development which takes place under the auspices of the United Nations Economic and Social Council.



## Support for national statistics

The Multidimensional Poverty Index is being developed to measure six poverty areas.



## Innovation

20,000 households from Chisinau reduced by 2% their electricity consumption after being informed that their neighbours receive lower electric bills or consume less. The experiment was conducted in partnership with Premier Energy.

Consumption of plastic was reduced by 5.5% as part of an experiment with METRO Cash and Carry.

UNDP is building a big data platform to reflect georeferenced data on Earth observation, urban mobility, electricity consumption to be used by the Chisinau municipality.



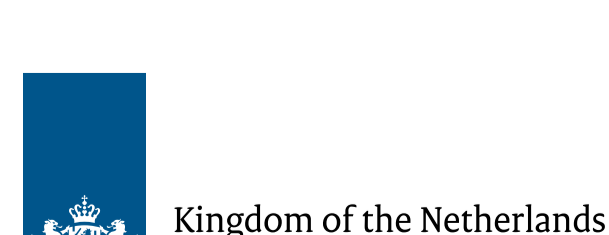
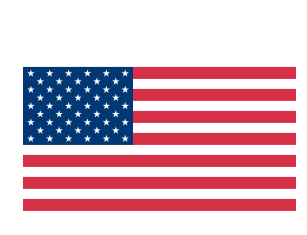


# EFFECTIVE GOVERNANCE

Our results in 2019

<b>Anticorruption</b>	<p>UNDP and rapper Kapushon launched an unprecedented anticorruption awareness raising campaign based on a song "If you've given if you've taken" that reached out to about 100,000 people through social media. 1800 young men and women from seven schools and universities of Moldova participated in thematic debates with the rapper and staff from the National Anticorruption Center.</p>	
	<p>The awareness raising campaigns on the legal protection of whistleblowers and on integrity standards in the private sector and among youth reached out to 1M people with the use of TV and social media.</p>	
	<p>Capacities of 129 civil servants appointed as institutional focal points on the National Integrity and Anti-corruption Strategy at the sector and local level in evidence-based monitoring and reporting had been strengthened through trainings.</p>	
<b>Support for security sector reform</b>	<p>The Central Clinical Military Hospital was endowed with modern medical equipment.</p>	
	<p>Capacities of 80 military personnel (senior commanders, psychologists and communication specialists) on gender equality issues and on the prevention and identification of gender-based non-discrimination was developed through a series of training.</p>	
	<p>Legal amendments expanding the right to the fourteen-day paternity leave over contracted military officers developed with UNDP support have been approved and 5 officers benefitted from this entitlement.</p>	
<b>Support for inclusive and transparent elections</b>	<p>UNDP scaled-up the inclusive electoral education for 5,741 direct and 1.76M indirect beneficiaries. Influenced by the electoral education activities, 12 representatives of Roma community were elected as local Councilors.</p>	
	<p>The elaborated Address Register Information System, unique in the region, will ensure more accurate assignment of voters to polling stations and better-quality public services.</p>	
	<p>Based on UNDP-led analysis that concluded that only 1% of 612 assessed stations corresponded to the accessibility standards, the Central Election Commission issued a recommendation to the mayors on adjusting the public buildings where the polling stations are usually opened.</p>	
	<p>The IT election interface developed by UNDP based on a crowdsourced design allowed to more than 2.7M men and women benefit from the real time data on the voter turnout and preliminary results. A new online tool – diaspora.voteaza.md offered information about polling stations opened abroad in a user-friendly format and was accessed by 47,965 users from 95 countries.</p>	
<b>Parliamentary Governance</b>	<p>Parliament Secretariat demonstrated enhanced skills and capacities to carry out the oversight function by implementing independently 41 ex-post legal assessments based on offered by UNDP methodology and knowledge.</p>	
	<p>The Handbook for the Members of Parliament, comprehensive infographics on legislature's functions, the Capacity Development Programme and templates for Frequently Asked Questions equipped the Parliament's Secretariat for the provision of the necessary support to the newly elected MPs for their swift integration within the legislature.</p>	
	<p>Capacities of the members and staff of the Gagauz People's Assembly in the area of legislative drafting and Results Based Management have been enhanced.</p>	
<b>Support to Police Reform</b>	<p>Network of police bike patrols was extended to four regions (Balti, Cahul, Leova, Cantemir) - 28 police officers (20 men, 8 women) trained and equipped to enhance security of women and men at the community level.</p>	
	<p>Effectiveness of police training system was improved by providing the Joint Law Enforcement Training Centre with specialized gear and equipment to build Police cadets' capacities and skills required for ensuring public order.</p>	
	<p>Capacities of the Joint Law Enforcement Training Centre to design and deliver police professional training were increased by building the adult learning skills of 17 trainers/law enforcement professionals.</p>	
<b>Justice</b>	<p>Justice training system was improved by aligning the processes of the National Institute of Justice to the requirements of ISO quality standards.</p>	





# INCLUSIVE GROWTH

Our results in 2019



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Prevention of gender-based violence	The first center for survivors of domestic violence in Gagauzia region is established, including the reconstruction of the building to host it.	
Migration for local development	UNDP's innovative experience of engaging 10,000 migrants in the development of 38 local communities was scaled-up at the national level through the Governmental Programme DAR 1+3.	
	Over 77.7K people from rural areas have improved access to local services and livelihoods as a result of 44 projects implemented by Home-town Associations. 4500 members of the diaspora were involved and contributed.	
Labour	New model of re-engineered public employment service was designed together with end-users.	
Confidence-building measures	Restoration works of Bender Fortress and Chisinau Circus started.	
	Reconstruction of 14 social infrastructure sites, 4 sport grounds, 2 culture houses, 4 kindergartens and schools started; 1 community center, 1 park, 1 street illumination and 1 waste management system are in process of upgrading. More than 70K people will benefit from improved social infrastructure objects.	
Capacities for trade	100 companies from both banks of the Nistru river got access to information about the opportunities provided by DCFTA, as well as the technical steps for development needed to access EU markets.	



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# CLIMATE CHANGE, ENVIRONMENT AND ENERGY

Area	Result	SDG
<b>Disaster-risk reduction</b>	990 houses of vulnerable families from 5 districts are equipped with smoke detectors and persons being informed on disaster risk prevention.	
<b>Green urban development</b>	Two solar trees which generate green energy were installed in Chisinau. The smart technology provides an annual CO2 reduction of 1400 kg.	
	30 charging stations for electric vehicles are in process of installation in Moldova.	
	10 innovative eco-friendly solutions were launched by private sector in Chisinau: air quality measurement sensors, 3D printed benches, reuse of electric cars batteries, conversion of food waste into soil fertilization.	
<b>Water law and diplomacy</b>	Moldovan negotiators of Nistru hydro power complex have better knowledge in the field of international water law and diplomacy.	
	A detailed field survey was conducted on five critical points of Nistru to support the Moldovan Government to better understand the impact of water quality and habitats produced by the hydropower development.	
<b>Waste management</b>	120 collecting points of e-waste were established in Chisinau and more than 50 tons of e-waste were collected.	
<b>Environment</b>	24 hectares of degraded land were rehabilitated by planting 13,000 trees.	
<b>Climate change</b>	The updated National Determined Contribution of the Republic of Moldova to the Paris Agreement was drafted. It contains more ambitious mitigation targets by 2030, as compared with the Initial National Determined Contribution (2015), 70% vs 64% for the unconditional scenario and 88% vs 78% for the conditional scenario, as compared with the reference year of 1990.	
<b>Climate Education</b>	Climate action has been popularized among 3100 youth through launching of the "Climate Box" education program which is being optionally applied in 155 schools across the country.	



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
