


This is the 1st Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP) MDG report Status of MDGs in KP tracking the progress of KP against the 8 Millennium Development Goals (MDGs). This report takes stock from a range of development data available from various sources, particularly PSLM data for 2007-08 and the provincially collated Multiplied Indicator Cluster Survey (MICS) data. The report also provides status of MDGs achieved across all districts of KP & highlights regional






Indicator: Proportion of children 12-23 Months Immunized against Measles
