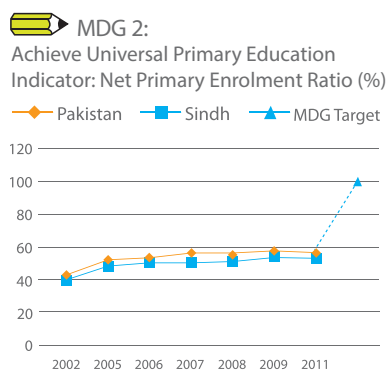
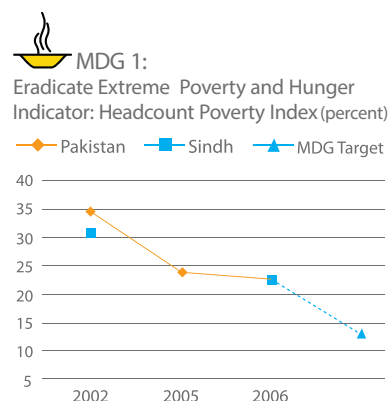
Large disparities across districts: Karachi 20% of Pakistan's GDP, Tharparkar among the poorest districts of Pakistan



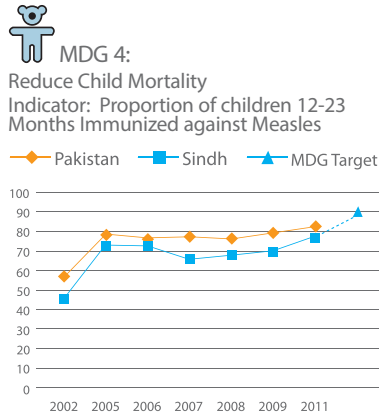
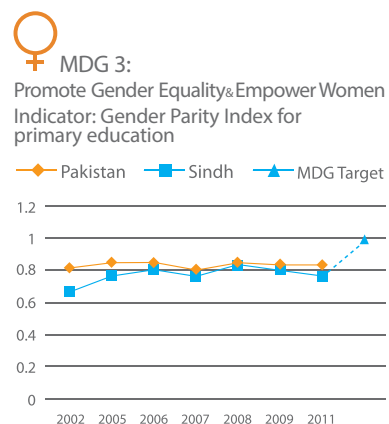
### Status of MDGs in Sindh

At the current rate of progress the province of **Sindh is unlikely to achieve MDGs** in their entirety by 2015 since progress shows wide discrepancies along rural and urban divides. **Out of 23 MDG indicators** Sindh has performed better than the national average **in 9 indicators.**

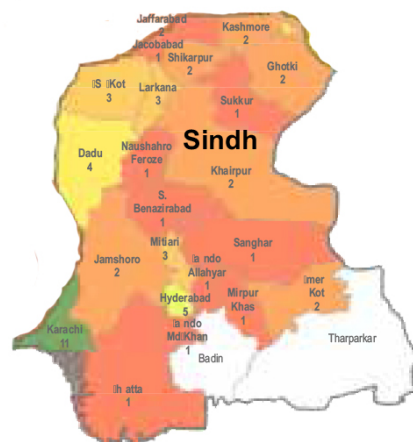
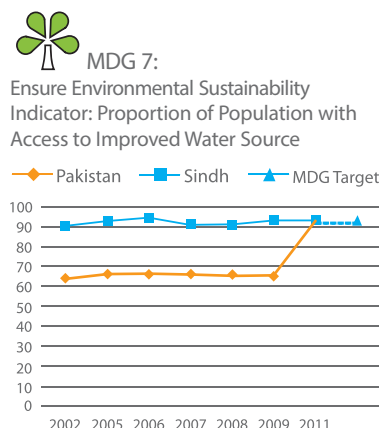
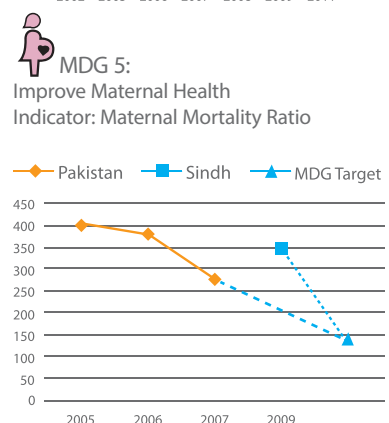
This is the 1st Sindh MDG report tracking the progress of Sindh against the 8 Millennium Development Goals (MDGs). This report takes stock from a range of development data available from various sources, particularly PSLM data for 2007-08 and the provincially collated Multiplied Indicator Cluster Survey (MICS) data. The report also provides status of MDGs achieved across all districts of Sindh & highlights regional disparities.
