

Main Achievements in 2018

- 13 trainees, of 53 initially enrolled, moved onto the final internship phase of the 6th Course for Magistrates and Public Defenders, and 29 trainees were accredited as private lawyers.
- Continuing legal training for current legal professionals from all judicial districts were conducted on civil liability, land laws, real rights, mediation, Portuguese and legal Tetun languages, and others. 85-100% of the participants responded satisfied with
- 708 cases were heard, of which 332 cases (329 criminal and 3 civil cases), involving approx. 689 beneficiaries (260 women) were resolved through Mobile Courts in 9 municipalities where no fixed courts exist.
- 70 cases were lodged at Access to Justice Clinics, involving 140
 (30 women) disputants residing in rural areas, and 23 cases (12
 land and 11 other types of civil cases) were resolved.
- Awareness-raising campaigns on the formal justice system, Law Against Domestic Violence, and Land Laws and mediation training for local leaders were conducted, reaching 3,895 people (1,295 women) in remote areas.
- Correctional facility inspection was introduced, consulting 48 inmates (9 women) and 13 correction officers (4 women).




