

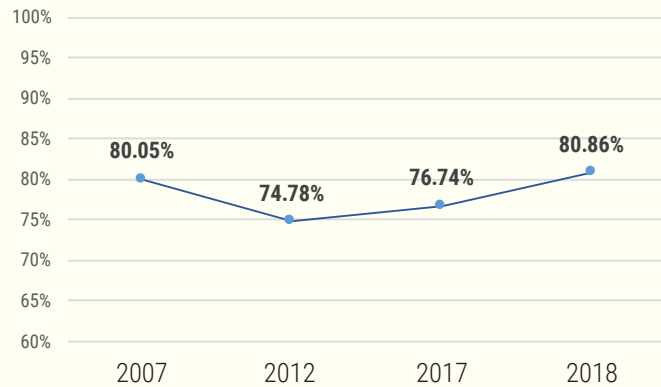

Turnout History of Parliamentary Elections in Timor-Leste



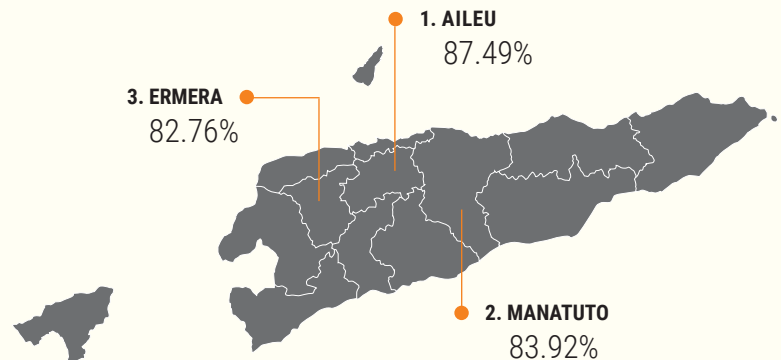

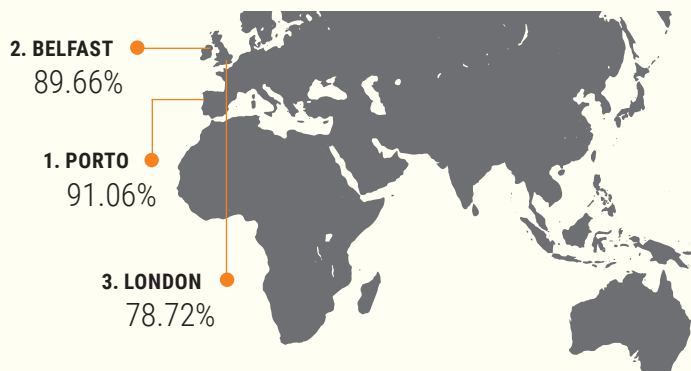

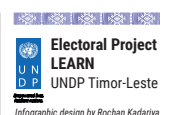
Highest Turnout in Municipality
