

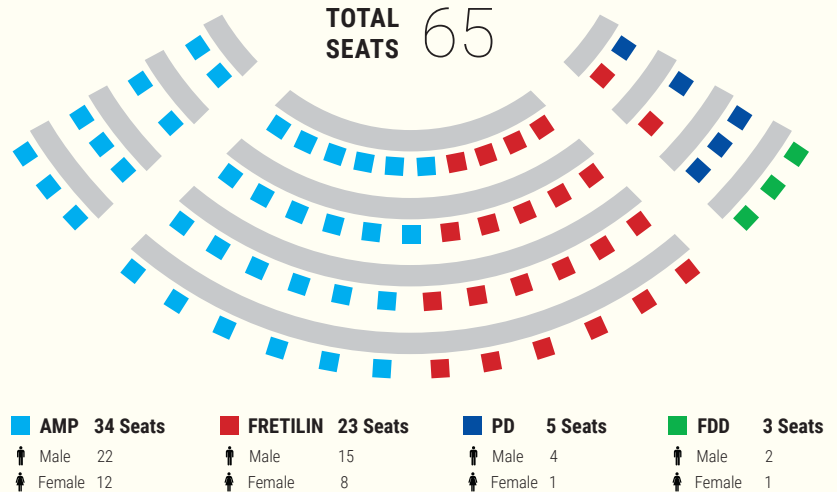
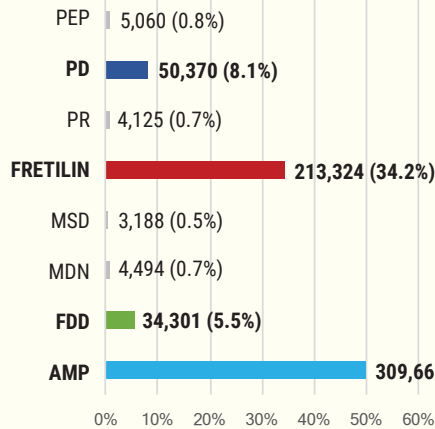

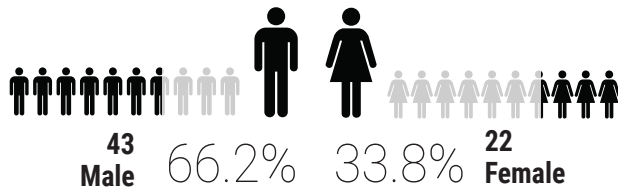
Final Results



Women representation in the National Parliament is based on list of candidates submitted by political parties and coalitions and might change after the first session of the elected parliament and formation of government.



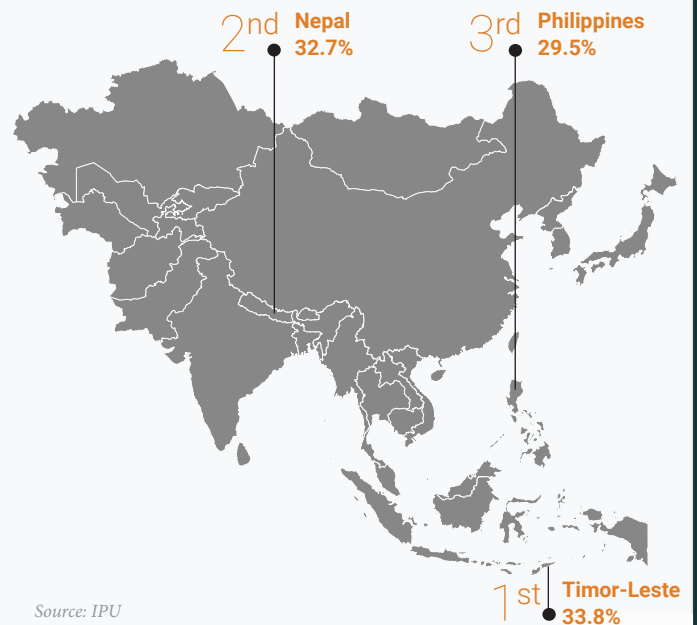
Women Representation in Parliament in TL

Total Voters (17+) 784,286



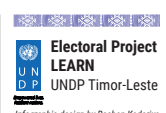
Total Turnout 80.98%
