Electoral Calendar for the Presidential Elections

Republic of Timor-Leste H.E. Taur Matan Ruak declared the dates for the Presidential Elections (both rounds) for 2017. The First round of presidential elections will take place on 20th March 2017. The President is elected through the system based on the majority of validly expressed votes, excluding blank votes. According to the legal framework, "Where no

The President of Democratic candidate gets more than half of the votes, a second round shall take place on the 30th day following the first voting". Therefore, if needed, second round of elections will take place on 20th April 2017.

The Technical Secretariat for Electoral Administration (STAE) has released the Operational Calendar for the Presidential elections after the announcement of the dates for 20th March 2017.

Operational Calendar The clearly provides the dates for each activity like submission of the candidacies to the President of the Supreme Court (STJ); time period to file an appeal against any candidate; the establishment of polling locations, electoral campaign period; activities for Election Day and post elections including counting of votes and publishing results; and other pre-requisite activities.





Nomination of Candidates

A total of eight persons submited their candidacy for 2017 presidential elections in Timor-Leste, including one female candidate.
