



#### National review

To undertake a review of the progress made and challenges encountered in Ukraine over the past 5 years, the State prepared a **national report** and CSOs (including a UNDP-supported CSO hub) prepared a **parallel report**.



#### Sub-regional

To outline sub-regionspecific achievements, gaps, and challenges, civil society (including a UNDP-supported CSO hub) from EaP countries and Romania prepared an **outcome document** in Chisinau on 4-5 September 2019.



### Regional review

To analyse key trends on gender equality across the ECE region, the regional review report was prepared and discussed at the Beijing+25 Regional Review Meeting in Geneva on 29-30 October 2019, where UNDP convened a side event and a session on women in leadership, bringing together government, parliament, and civil society.


