



THOUGHTS AND VIEWS OF THE POPULATION OF UKRAINE

December 2020 (Omnibus)

The survey was conducted by the Kyiv International Institute of Sociology from 24 November to 17 December 2020 using the CATI (computer-assisted telephone interviews) methodology, based on a random sample of mobile phone numbers. The sample is representative for the adult population (aged 18 years and over) of Ukraine.

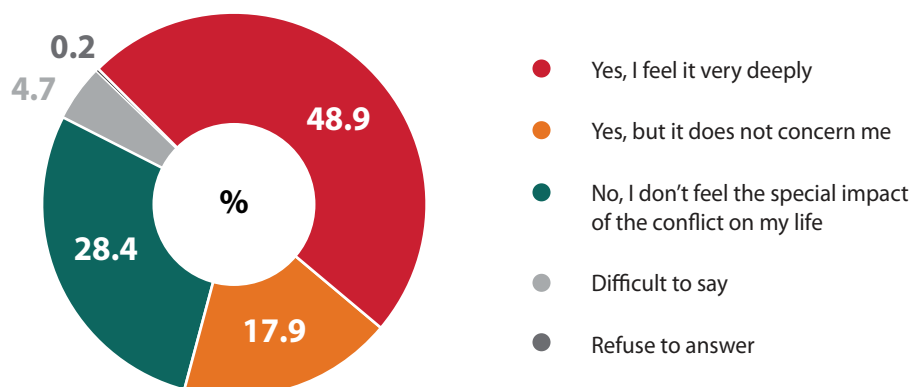
The survey was conducted in all oblasts of Ukraine, except for the temporarily non-government-controlled areas – the Autonomous Republic of Crimea, some areas of the Donetsk and Luhansk oblasts.

The field survey lasted from 8-15 December 2020 and resulted in the collection of 2,000 questionnaires.

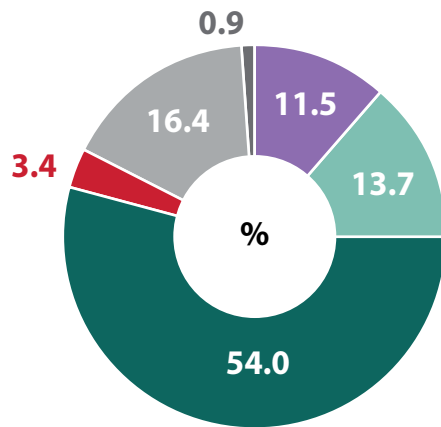
Weighting was applied in order to compensate for deviations from official statistics (State Statistics Service as of 1 January 2019). To calculate the indicators, the data set should be weighted (variable weight).

The sampling error (with a probability of 0.95 and taking into account the design effect of 1.1) does not exceed: 2.4% for indicators close to 50%, 2.1% for indicators close to 25%, and 1.5% for indicators close to 10%.

Do you personally feel that there is an armed conflict in Ukraine?

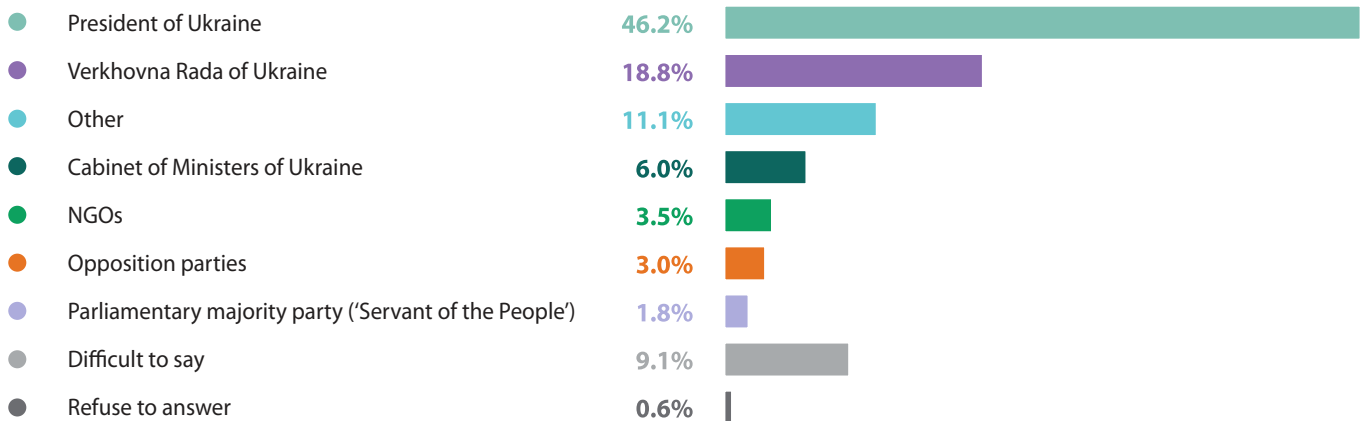


When, in your opinion, should a state action plan for the transition from an armed conflict to peace be developed?

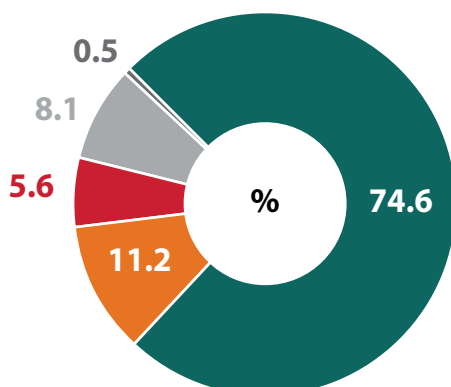


- Once the non-government-controlled territories become government-controlled territories

Who, in your opinion, should initiate the development of the state action plan for the transition from the armed conflict to peace?



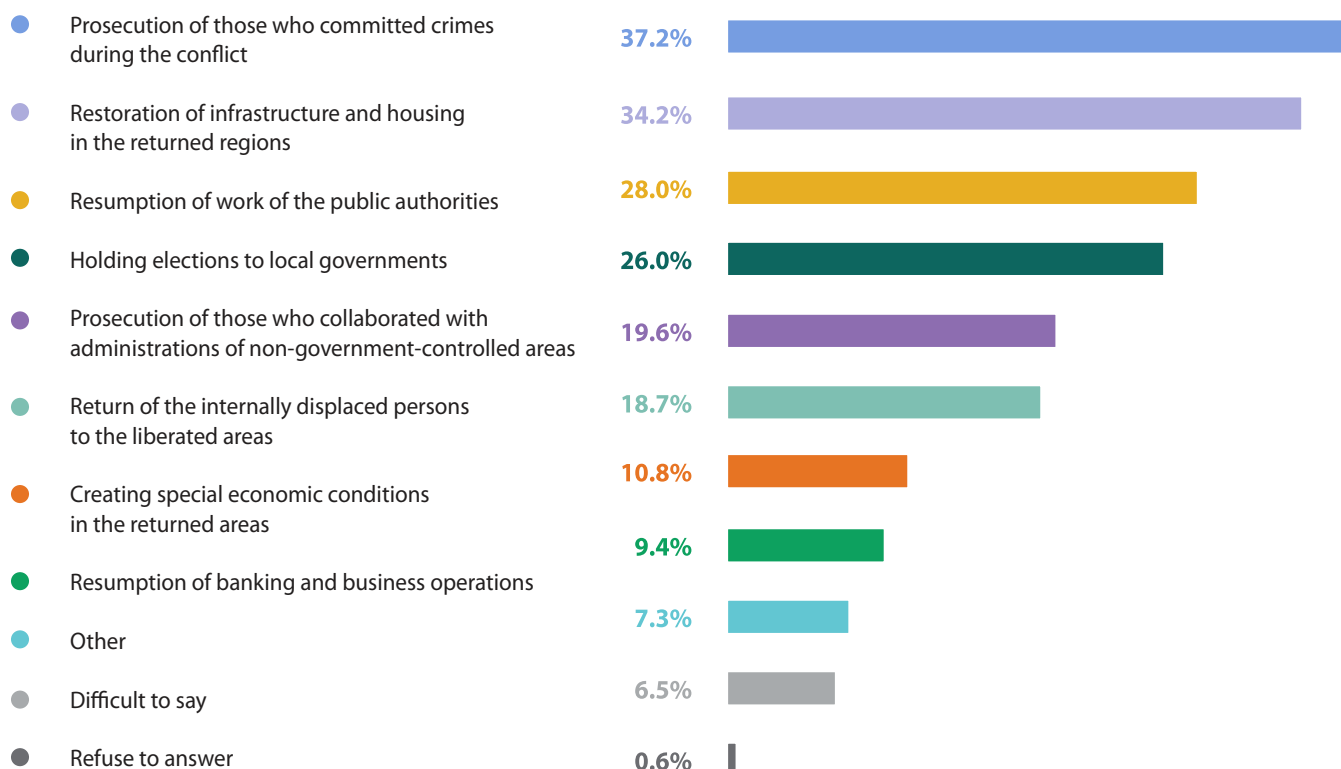
Should the state take measures to maintain and preserve ties with residents of the non-government-controlled areas (parts of Luhansk and Donetsk oblasts and Crimea)?
