
LEAVE NO ONE BEHIND



Vietnam has achieved most of MDGs at national level

..but not in ethnic minority and mountainous areas across all MDGs. In some MDGs such as universal primary education, maternal health, child mortality and environmental sustainability, the gap between these areas and the national level is still large.

This process requires the following prioritized actions:



Institutionalize and integrate of the MDGs for ethnic minorities into national and provincial socio-economic development plans 2016-2020 as well as in the sectoral plans;



Enhance community empowerment and people participation, promote self-help spirit and mobilize indigenous knowledge of ethnic minority communities;



Develop new partnership mechanism to better engage development partners, private sector and social organizations in the process to leave no one behind.

Prerequisites for successful implementation of these actions are "engagement and efforts for actions of line ministries, local government and self-reliance of local people and communities". The solemn handshake is not enough
