ECONOMIC AND LIVELIHOOD SUPPORT

2,803 workers
(28% women, 60% youth) benefitted from short-term employment through cash-for-work and greater awareness of COVID-19 preventive measures



116 MSMEs from the informal sector received grants to ensure business continuity and improve their awareness of COVID-19 preventive measures



HEALTH EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROGRAMME

Signed an agreement with Taiz's Ministry of Health and Population Office for courier services from health facilities to central lab



59 healthcare workers trained in safe environmental and medical waste management



450 jump suits

2,900 non-medical face masks

1,830 face-shield produced by MSMEs in Aden

5 solar powered tuk-tuk motorcycles procured for COVID-19 sample transport from health facilities to central lab in Taiz



1 centralized medical waste incinerator installed in Aden to ensure safe disposal of medical materials



RAPID FINANCING FACILITY (RFF)

Preparation for solar tuk-tuk maintenance training for **145** poor and vulnerable heads of households

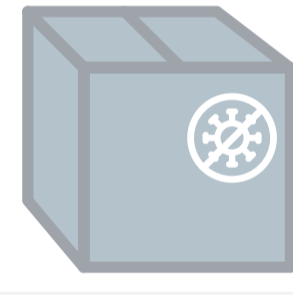


REBUILDING LIVELIHOODS AND CAPACITIES OF CONFLICT-AFFECTED SMALL-SCALE FISHERIES HOUSEHOLDS IN ADEN AND HADHRAMOUT

1,000 Yemenis improved their COVID-19 awareness and received personal protective equipment (10% women)



150 Yemenis received occupational safety kits to ensure COVID-19 safe technical training



500 fisherfolk selected to receive cash grants and fishing equipment to establish or grow micro-enterprises



100 fisherfolk selected to receive boats and engines to help them to increase their income

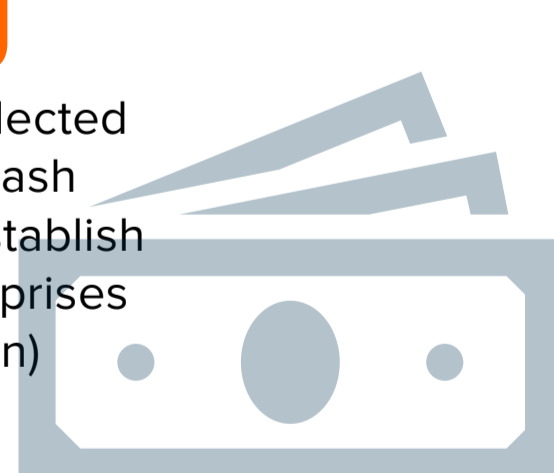


BUILDING RESILIENT LIVELIHOODS AND IMPROVING PROTECTION SERVICES FOR CONFLICT AFFECTED COMMUNITIES IN ADEN AND LAHJ

1,000 Yemenis selected to receive COVID-19 awareness training and personal protective equipment (50% women)



1,000 Yemenis selected to receive cash grants to establish micro-enterprises (50% women)



SUPPORT WOMEN EMPOWERMENT FOR GENDER JUSTICE AND HEALTH SECURITY

Promoting women's leadership in peace and security in wake of heightened violence due to COVID-19

500 COVID-19 hygiene kits provided for security actors, including women police in Aden and Mukalla



500 security actors trained in gender-sensitive and human rights-compliant response to COVID-19



40 women police, social, and health workers in Aden and Mukalla trained in gender justice and health security (**240** in 2021)



Participation of women leaders in government-led COVID-19 Risk Communication and Community Engagement (RCCE) Coordination Fora in Aden and Mukalla

GBV referral pathways updated to provide more effective protection services to survivors during public health crisis

Mukalla's Ministry of Population and Health Office issued official letter to formalize women's participation and representation in public health decision-making and coordination forums

Interagency Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) drafted in partnership with Ministry of Interior, Ministry of Social Affairs and Labour, and Ministry of Population and Health, to address and prevent gender-discriminatory socio-economic consequences of COVID-19 – including protection of GBV survivors, detainees, and persons with disabilities



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
