




July 2020 COVID-19 Factsheet

COVID-19 Community Outreach

4,800,000	Yemenis received information through radio campaigns and UNDP's social media platforms	264,000	Yemenis received information through rural household campaigns
100,000	Masks produced by Village Community Committee (VCC) members	100,000	Leaflets disseminated
18,930	VCC awareness raising youth members in over 2,000 villages mobilized	16,400	Workers received awareness and prevention information and provided masks, gloves and cleaning materials
4,752	Households received awareness raising and hygiene kits	4,500	Self-help youth initiatives to raise awareness and distribute materials

Livelihoods Support

1,440	Farmers received cash transfers and technical assistance to cope and improve productivity (450 related to YECRP KSA)
300	Implemented sub-projects in WASH, agricultural lands, and rural roads provided income to over 50,000 workers and families, enabling purchase of necessities

Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise Support (MSMEs)

12	Aden-based MSMEs trained to produce liquid soap in collaboration with For All Fund (FAF) (soap production started)
8-hr.	Intense Train the Trainers conducted for liquid soap industry (support from FAF)
10	Trainers/advisors trained to support soap and mask MSMEs in Bani-Qais and Az Zuharah (Hajjah governorate)

Health System Support

1,395	Health workers trained in COVID-19 prevention measures
8	Health centers received 5,150 pairs of medical gloves, 5,600 medical masks, and 143 containers of 5-liters soap in Aden, Hadramaut, and Lahj
757,000	People benefited from 10 handwashing stations (200 liters) distributed to 8 health centers in Aden, Lahj, and Hadramaut
3	Health facilities received support from Rapid Response Facility (hospital solar systems, personal protective equipment, hand washing stations repairs, and incentive payments to medical staff) (Hodeidah's Zaidiyah Hospital, Hajjah Isolation Center, and Amanat Al-Asimah Police Hospital Isolation Center)

Law Enforcement Institutions Support

+250	Civil Defense Authority Sana'a-based staff benefited from over 450 masks, 25 hygiene kits, 11 protective uniforms, 11 medical gloves, 162 gloves for cleaners, 5 pump sprays (16 liters), and cleaning equipment.
