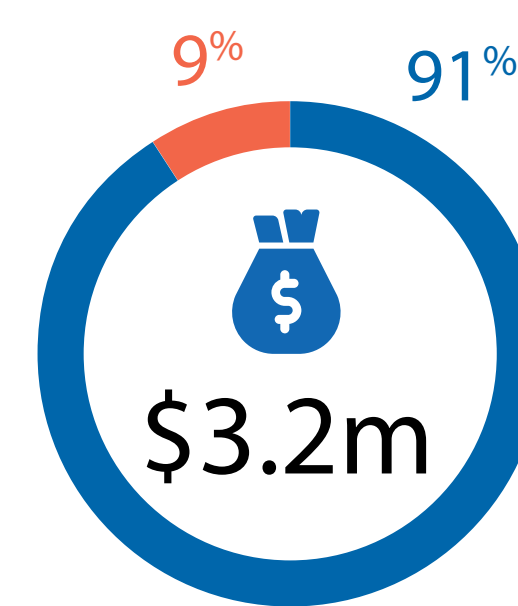
OBJECTIVE

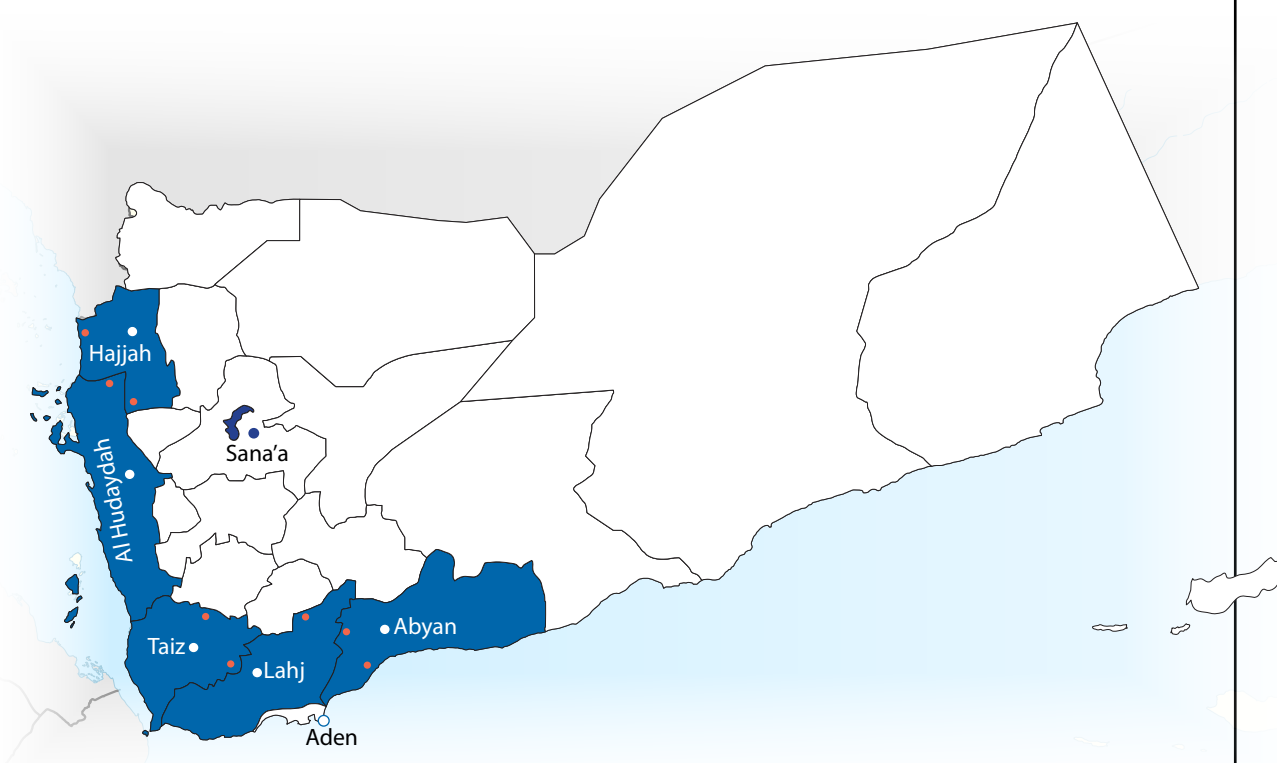

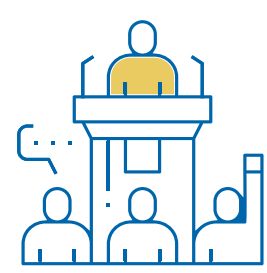

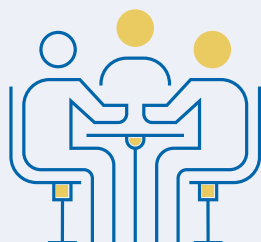


Establishment or reactivation of VCCs & SDCs

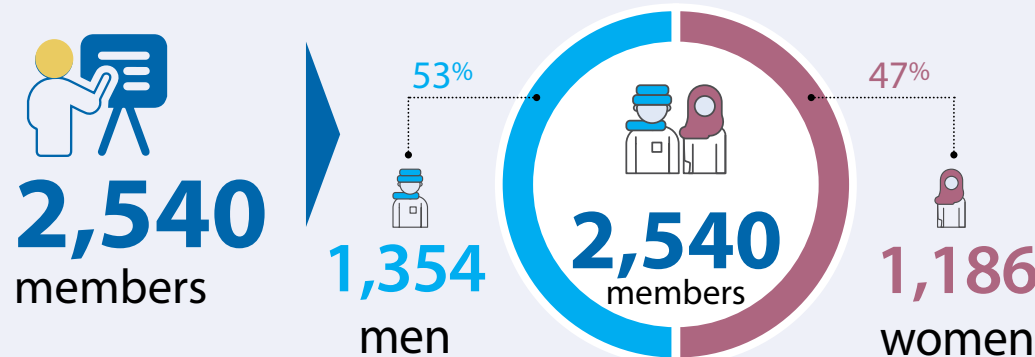

Health Sector

16 Health facilities rehabilitated, extended, or constructed.

50 Villages benefited

25K beneficiaries



Education Sector

73 Classrooms built or rehabilitated

10 School bathrooms built or rehabilitated

4 School water reservoirs built or rehabilitated

9 Classrooms equipped

2 solar systems provided to two schools

More than 6K students (45% girls) benefited



Water and Sanitation

10 water reservoirs built or rehabilitated

6 water solar pumps provided and installed

1 sewerage network repaired

over 25K beneficiaries

More than 8K metres of water networks installed or rehabilitated

230 metres of sewerage network installed, benefiting around 1,000 households.



Roads

More than 6K metres of roads paved or constructed

50 villages benefited

60K beneficiaries
