UNDP and local partners, Public Works Project (PWP) and Nahda Makers Organization (NMO), work together to rehabilitate, build and provide infrastructure and equipment that will:

2. Contribute to a **stronger economy** by increasing productivity



3. Revitalize **stability** by allowing communities to enjoy the benefits of **peace**

By building local knowledge and capacity in water and sanitation, the interventions aim to ensure sustainability and healthier, cleaner future for all Yemenis.

Since December 2018, UNDP has provided critical support to the cleaning funds (CF) and local corporations for water supply and sewerage (LCWSS) in Aden and Mukalla including:

1. CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE

Helping municipal operations continue by providing:

50 public dumpsters

30 walkie talkies ¹ for CF to ensure proper monitoring and communicating

25 garbage trucks ²

16 motorcycles and 4 tuk-tuks for garbage collection and monitoring ³

3 generators and electrical equipment (fans, refrigerators and air conditioners) for CF workshops to ease task completion

solar power system installed for Aden CF and Water Corporation to ensure continuous power availability

spare parts for bobcat and truck scale (weighbridge) ⁴

furniture, ICT and office supplies for local authorities

Increasing local capacity for water and sanitation services through the rehabilitation of:

12 public toilets in Mukalla central market

12 engines and cabling to run boreholes ⁵

11 electric submersible pumps for Mukalla City Water Corporation

7 water pumps and accessories ⁶ for sewerage water pumping stations

2 local CF offices in Aden ⁷

2 maintenance workshops ⁸

hangers, service centre and washing bays in Mukalla

water network in Al-Talai area in the west of Old Fuwah ⁹

Al Ghuwaizi Castle sewage system in Mukalla

furniture, ICT and office supplies for local authorities

electrical equipment (fans, refrigerators and air conditioners)

Al Mansura sewage pumping station building
