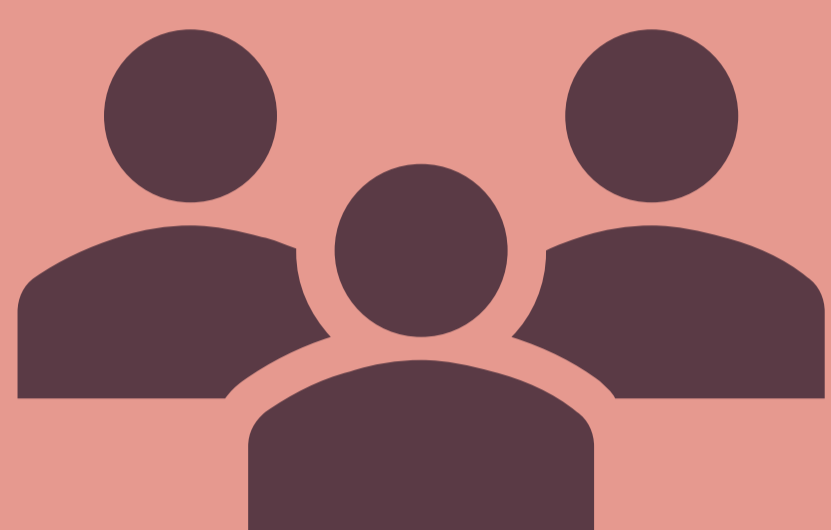

## Helping Communities Cope with COVID-19 in ALL GOVERNORATES



### COVID-19 Community Outreach

- **168,000** individuals from 30,000 households received critical information and awareness materials
- **8 public latrines and hand washing stations** with COVID-19 awareness posters installed to ensure access to sanitation services in crowded urban centers<sup>1</sup>

### Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise Support (MSMEs)

- **5,515 smallholder** farmers, fishermen, and livestock breeders received cash assistance and technical support
- **50 litres** of liquid hand soap produced
- **40,000 non-surgical masks** ordered by Aden's Ministry of Health

In total, UNDP-supported MSMEs have produced **50,000 non-surgical masks** and **300 hospital gowns** with a revenue of about **YER 8 million (US\$ 13,200)**



### Economic and Livelihood Support

- **52,000 women** with high needs due to COVID-19, received cash assistance to purchase food and essential goods
- **Over 300 COVID-19-sensitive\* sub-projects** in WASH, agriculture, and roads under implementation across 22 governorates
- **Over 15,000 people** participated in short-term employment, enabling the purchase of essential goods and PPE for about 90,000 family members

*\*Precautions include safe distancing, sanitation, and personal protective equipment*



### Health System Support

- Activities for Aden's *COVID-19 Emergency Health Response and Recovery* project started with WHO support:
  - Selected medical provider and healthcare facility
  - Completed rapid assessment of private healthcare providers
  - Developed community survey
- Hodeidah's Al-Zaidiya Hospital received critical testing equipment to boost response capacity
- **53 specialized doctors** hired to conduct COVID-19 prevention training for field consultants

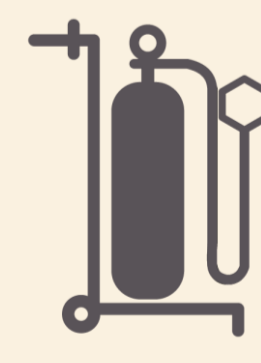
